- 2021 Pet Nat, Poggio Anima 'Il Mostaro Ragana', Abruzzo, IT 82
A blend of Pecorino and Chardonnay, from one of Tuscany's rising stars Riccardo Campinoti. Sapid, saline and delightfully refreshing
- MV Brut, Clover Hill 'Exceptionelle' Pipers River TAS 140
On Tasmania's northern edge, cooled by the Bass straight mere kilometers north of the vineyards, the team at Clover Hill have perfected the harnessing of acidity and freshness, without sacrificing generosity and texture
- NV Franciacorta, Mirabella Blanc De Blancs 'Edea' Lombardy, IT 150
Probably the second-most famous Italian sparkling wine style has a case to be recognised as it's highest quality. In the high hills of Lombardy, a relatively young wine region with aspirations of beating Champagne at its own game
- 2011 Stefano Lubiana 'Grande Vintage' Derwent Valley, TAS 175
Epic vintage sparkling from South TAS - Ten years on lees builds powerful creamy texture with a backbone of bright acid from high Chardonnay percentage and cool weather
- NV Salamino Blend, Lini 910 'Lambrusco Rosso' Emilia-Romagna, IT 77
Full-blooded Lambrusco from some long-standing organic legends from Emilia-Romagna. Once described as 'The best Lambrusco in the world' by Gambero Rosso

NV Lallier Brut 'R019' Champagne, FR 175

A unique expression with 88% of the base wine coming from the 2019 vintage, Lallier's 'Reflexions' range prides itself on being emblematic of the growing conditions of the base vintage, with a small percentage of reserve wines for balance and extra complexity

NV Bonnaire 'Terroirs, Blanc de Blancs' Champagne, FR 195

From a grand cru site on the Cote de Blancs comes this sensational grower-producer has created an epitomical expression of Blanc de Blancs Champagne. Freshness and texture

NV Ruinart 'Brut' Champagne, FR 235

With history going back to the early 1700s, it's fair to say Ruinart have earned their place amongst Champagnes' most esteemed producers. This wine, featuring classic cépages of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Meunier, shows tremendous balance and complexity

NV Taittinger 'Prelude' Grands Crus Champagne, FR 294

The ultimate craft expression of Taittinger's blends - a 50/50 Pinot Noir and Chardonnay split, sourced from only Grand Cru vineyards. An exceptionally gentle pressing to ensure great purity, then five years' élevage for texture and complexity. A perfect match for any food, or, just, by itself

NV Egly-Ouriet 'Les Premices' Champagne, FR 341

A blend of sites from Trigny, equal parts Pinot Noir, Meunier and Chardonnay; tremendous expression of the terroir maintained by the estate. Extended lees aging, and resting only in tanks to ensure purity to balance depth and complexity

NV Egly-Ouriet 'Grand Cru' Champagne, FR 594

An expression of the Grand-Cru sites that Egly-Ouriet maintain, within Ambonnay, Bouzy and Verzeney. Majority Pinot with a long time on lees, the wine is full bodied with savoury edges and a distinct saline current. A bold and impressive grower Champagne

NV Krug 'Grande Cuvée' 171eme edt. Champagne, FR 465

The pinnacle of the blender's art. Composed in 2015 from 40% reserve wines, the Krug Grande Cuvée has always stood as emblematic to richness, expression and elegance

Champagne, Vintage

- 2017 Laherte Freres 'Vignes D'Autrefois' Champagne, FR 337
100% Meunier from old vine sites (planted 1947-1964!) around Chavot and Mancy. Biodynamically managed, all the cellar work is done in old oak over the course of seven months, and the resultant wine is as bright and crunchy as it is dense and textural
- 2015 Paul Bara 'Special Club' Champagne, FR 352
The wines of Paul Bara are invariably Pinot Noir dominant, subject to extended élevage and are considered to carry a purity of fruit and a focus unmatched by all but the absolute best in the region. If you've never had a chance to try a Special Club Champagne, it's a bucket list for any lover of fine wine
- 2015 Louis Roederer 'Rosé Vintage' Champagne, FR 310
Soft-pressed Pinot Noir delicately balanced with some Chardonnay, all sourced from the famous 'La Rivières' Vineyards - an exceptional vintage has brought about a phenomenal combination of crunchy acid and buoyant fruit flavours, and judicious use of oak and malolactic fermentation build a generous texture around that
- 2013 Dom Perignon 'Vintage Brut' Champagne, FR 565
The 2013 vintage is the perfect example of the resonance of Pinot Noir and Chardonnays. A fantastic showcasing of tension and expressiveness, acidity and body, accompanied by precision and ethereal elegance. Laden with orange fruits, citrus and the trademark Dom Perignon smoke making for great drinking now, or in the future
- 2007 Taittinger 'Comtes de Champagne' Blanc de Blancs Champagne, FR 700
In the eyes of many, Taittinger's signature Blanc de Blancs Champagne is one of the highest quality and most sought after Champagnes of all time. They'd certainly be fair for thinking that with a bottle like this. Richness and depth draped over citrus freshness and bright complexity
- 2008 Krug 'Vintage Brut' Champagne, FR 936
From an iconic Champagne house, in an iconic vintage; the 2008 Krug Vintage Brut can be considered Krug at its very best; and when Krug's standard level is already exceptional, it goes without saying this could be one of the finest Champagnes one might ever have a chance to drink.

Riesling and Riesling-esque

- 2017 Semillon, Tyrrell's 'Stevens Vineyard' Hunter Valley, NSW 98
One of Australia's most important wine families, and whilst their iconic 'Vat 1' is one of the most famous varietal Semillon in the world, it's their single vineyard wines they truly pride themselves on
- 2022 Riesling, Ministry of Clouds Clare Valley, SA 94
Julian and Bernice of Ministry of Clouds, in addition to being lovely people, also hold a keen eye for quality fruit and a deft touch with winemaking. Clare Valley Riesling in the Goldilocks zone of Acid, texture and fruit
- 2023 Riesling, Grosset Wines 'Polish Hill' Clare Valley, SA 172
Inarguably, one of Australia's most iconic Rieslings. Organic and biodynamic practices in a 'Hard Rock' site dominated by blue slate producing powerful, aromatic Riesling of the highest quality
- 2022 Riesling, Frankland Estate 'Isolation Ridge' Frankland River, WA 135
Pioneer producers in the south of WA and amongst the first to really shine a light on the potential for Riesling in that area, the Frankland river single vineyards are only going from strength to strength
- 2023 Riesling, Gentle Folk 'Village' Adelaide Hills SA 115
A moment of realisation led to a paradigm shift for Gareth Belton; if you have high altitude, cool climate, steep sloped Riesling Vineyards, why would you make it dry, when all of greatest rieslings of all time have done otherwise given the same conditions? Off dry, crystal pure and laser focussed, as all great Rieslings are
- 2021 Falanghina, Chalmers Heathcote, VIC 88
The Chalmers mission to explore the potential for new varieties in Australia continues with this thrilling expression of a classic Campanian variety. Fresh, complex and elegant; makes you wonder why no one else thought of it first
- 2022 Riesling, GD Vajra 'Petracine,' Piemonte IT 195
A great example of the potential in the new Langhe; a mineral laden, steely and structured Riesling that can go toe to toe with the greatest dry whites in the world

Gris and Grigio-esque

- 2021 Müller Thurgau, Manni Nossing 'Sass Rigais' Südtirol, IT 150
High in the Dolomites near the Austrian border, Manni Nossing carves out his own little niche for incredibly pure alpine wines. At 800m asl and on less than a single hectare, Müller exemplifies the style for which he's known
- 2022 Manzoni Bianco, Foradori 'Fontanasanta' Trentino-Alto Adige, IT 130
Always one of the most anticipated wines from the Foradori releases. Grown in clay soils rich in limestone, overlooking the idyllic mountains of Trentino. A cross between Riesling and Pinot Bianco with a minimal amount of time spent on skins for some added stability
- 2021 Pinot Grigio, Albino Armani 'io' Trentino-Alto Adige, IT 88
As Pinot Grigio as Pinot Grigio gets - classic is an understatement for this wine, with minerality, pear and flowers
- 2022 Grillo, Funaro 'Pinzeri' Sicily, IT 99
A modern winery started by siblings in 2003, using a wide range of organically farmed grapes from just outside of Palermo on Sicily's Northwest Coast. Pure and expressive grillo, bright orchard fruits and seaspray
- 2021 Garganega, Pieropan Soave Classico 'Calvarino' Veneto, IT 165
Top quality Soave on the 'fresh and mineral' side of things. Rising icon producer working on steep slopes to create a wine of freshness and energy
- 2022 Pinot Gris Blend, La Violetta 'P. Gris + Amis' Great Southern, WA 86
Easy drinking aromatic white blend from our favourite producer out of WA. Part Riesling, part Pinot Gris, all delicious
- 2021 Pigato, Cascina Feipu dei Massaretti, Liguria IT 115
Liguria's answer to the Vermentino and Rolle of the neighbouring regions bears the freshness, expression and seaspray you'd expect of the steep terraced vineyards they're grown on
- 2021 Arneis, Giovanni Rosso Roero, Piedmont, IT 105
A relatively unheralded variety in Australia, Arneis carries the tremendous balance of aromatics and texture which make it a perfect accompaniment to our food and culture

2021 Bussanello, Crotin 'Pilsun', Piemonte, IT	104	
A fascinating project from the hills of Monferrato, bringing us a relatively obscure yet exciting variety. Crossing Furmint with Riesling Italico, Bussanello presents bright citrus fruits and waxy texture		
2020 Trebbiano, Noelia Ricci 'Bro' Emilia Romagna, IT	107	
Having only bottled the first vintage of Noelia Ricci in 2013, this young Romagna-based project is seeking a contemporary and fresh approach to classic wines of the region. Bright fruit character and texture, backed with a nice tannic grip and a touch of salt		
2020 Garganega Blend, Giuseppe Quintarelli 'Bianco Secco' Veneto, IT	225	
From one of northern Italy's most legendary producers of red wines, his most underrated offering - a textural, detailed IGT combining indigenous and introduced grapes, resulting in a wine that truly speaks about where it's from		
2021 Langhe DOC Bianco, Luigi Baudana 'Dragon' Serralunga D'Alba, Piemonte, IT	104	
A co-planted, co-harvested and co-fermented blend of both indigenous and non-indigenous grapes, with a short time in stainless steel - this is a perfect window into the terroir of Serralunga D'Alba		
2019 Garganega Blend, Balestri Valda Soave 'Vigneto Sengialta' Veneto, IT	159	
From champions of biodiversity, terroir and beekeeping in Veneto; Soave with minerality, power, and finesse. Subtle floral tones and a lick of honey		
2022 House Made Chardonnay Blend by MJ Corbett Riverland, SA	On Tap/500ml	45
A white of equal parts freshness and texture from a rising star in South Australian winemaking		

Savoury, Textured

- 2021 Pigato, Selvadolce 'Crescendo' Liguria, IT 143
A powerful, dialled-up expression of Pigato from biodynamically farmed vineyards just a off the French border. A mixture of steel and oak, skin maceration and crisp ocean breezes all play their part in the wine's tremendous texture and complexity
- 2022 Savagnin, Amato Vino 'Space Girls' Margaret River, WA 98
From one of Western Australia's most forward-thinking winemakers; organically grown Savagnin, touch of old oak, lees and a short soak to build tension, texture and energy
- 2022 Fiano, Ricca Terra Farms, Riverlands SA 73
Fiano is quickly building a reputation for being tough, fresh and full of flavour, this is all on display here. Refreshing, textual and lively
- 2020 Collio Blend, Edi Keber 'K' Friuli-Venezia Giulia, IT 181
An organic farm in the Commons, a hill called Zegla; Edi Keber produces one wine only. It is a blend, known as Collio, and can easily be considered a pre-eminent example of a wine of terroir. A special wine of energy
- 2021 Textural White Blend, JC's Own 'Freestyler' Barossa Valley, SA 92
This is what happens when you let a classic winemaker loose in his own backyard. Chenin Blanc, Chardonnay, Sav B, Crouchen, you know, the usual suspects. T E X T U R E
- 2022 Savagnin, Entropy Wines 'Willow Grove' Gippsland, VIC 118
Through experience with the region's pre-eminent natural wine producers, Ryan and Ashlee Ponsford have gained vital insight into divining the best out of Gippsland's Baw Baw Shire. Balance, precision, mineral and driven. This slightly oxidative Savaginon is an ode to wines of the Jura
- 2021 Bosco Blend, a Scia Cinque Terre DOC Liguria, IT 169
From steep terraces on the Ligurian coastline, the wines of Cinque Terre have been written about for centuries. Local grapes like Bosco are blended with Vermentino and Albarola, with time spent in first and second use French barriques to create a wine of structure and presence, with a distinct mediterranean expression

Powerful, Volcanic Whites of Sicily

2019 Carricante/Moscato, Tenuta di Castellaro 'Bianco Porticello' Lipari, Sicily, IT 115

In an idyllic position within the Aeolian Archipelago off Sicily's East coast, Tenuta di Castellaro crafts wines that only seek to express their surroundings. This wine, made from indigenous grapes grown organically, recalls the white sand beaches of Lipari and 'Summer in a glass'

2021 Minella Blend, Eduardo Torres Acosta 'Versante Nord' Sicily, IT 158

A blend predominantly made up of the lesser known varietal Minella Bianca, accompanied by other varietals also native to Sicily. A short maceration on skins, this is a wine highlighted by mineral salinity, power and poise

2021 Catarratto, Alessandro Di Camporeale, Monreale DOC Sicily, IT 125

From a family owned, organically managed vineyard in Western Sicily, the geography of the area creates conditions more like the continental environments experienced around the regions of Burgundy. Pure, precise and textural

2022 Carricante, Le Vigne de Eli Etna Bianco, Castiglione di Sicilia, Sicily, IT 155

The second major project from Marco di Grazia (Tenuta delle Terre Nere) harnessing high-altitude vineyards around the Moganazzi-Voltaciara on the Volcano's north-east. Named for his young daughter, Elena, these precious examples from these tiny little parcels are a fantastic, heartfelt little project showing Etna's finer qualities

2020 Carricante, Maugeri Etna Bianco Superiore, Contrada Volpare 'Frontebosco' Milo, Sicily, IT 260

From an idyllic family-owned property in Milo, positioned on Etna's eastern slope; a thin slice of land between the volcano and the sea. Here is the only place production of Etna Bianco Superiore is allowed and the family makes no light of the privilege to make wine there. Power, texture and minerality all wrapped up

Chardonnay and Chardonnay-esque

- 2018 Timorasso, Claudio Mariotto 'Cavallina' Piemonte, IT 176
From the brink of extinction due to its difficulty growing evenly, Timorasso is making a resurgence due to a core group of vignerons who are applying themselves to producing thought provoking expressions, proving the result is worth the effort. Claudio Mariotto is arguably one of the best. Texture and minerality meet tension and structure
- 2021 Viognier, Yerringberg Yarra Valley, VIC 125
This varietal is a relative newcomer to this iconic estate. Wine maker Sandra de Pury opts to pick this wine over a few weeks, first for freshness, spice and acidity, second picking adding weight and opulence. A wine that offers tension, texture and restrained power
- 2021 Chardonnay, Massimo Rivetti 'Botticella' Piemonte, IT 147
A fifth generation family run vineyard steeped in tradition and respect for the land they farm on. Cultivated under organic certification and aged in French oak, this is an elegant example of freshness and structure whilst still showcasing elements expected of a Chardonnay from Langhe
- 2023 Chardonnay, M+J Becker Hunter Valley, NSW 76
Off the now famed Ablington estate in the Hunter, with a selection from other, sustainably farmed vineyards in the area, M+J Becker continue to impress with a wonderful balance of texture, length and structure
- 2021 Chardonnay, Gilbert 'Nashdale' Orange, NSW 115
From one of Australia's most lauded young winemakers, a dense and precise version of high altitude, cool climate Chardonnay. Pleasing density and lacey oak backed with fresh aromatic citrus notes. Class
- 2023 Chardonnay, Serere, Whitlands, VIC 118
Year after year, Joe Warren's Serere project from the Whitlands and Beechworth in Victoria's north continues to impress with wonderful balance between texture and freshness, purity and complexity

Chardonnay

- 2022 Chardonnay, Cullen Wines 'Kevin John', Margaret River, WA 325
In 1971 the Cullen Estate was planted, since then chemical intervention has been minimal and the family's concern for the land they farm paramount. Gaining their biodynamic certification in 2003, the quality of the wines has never wavered. Driven by mineral acidity, supported by balance and poise. A prime example of what diligent practices can achieve
- 2023 Chardonnay, Tyrrell's 'HVD' Hunter Valley, NSW 205
Planted in 1908, it's believed that the Tyrrell's HVD vineyard is the oldest consistently productive Chardonnay Vineyard in the world. Energetic, tense and fresh, HVD shows light flinty reduction and delicate oak interwoven with fresh citrus and floral character
- 2022 Chardonnay, Ministry of Clouds Adelaide Hills, SA 127

Stanko Radikon, Collio Gorizia di Friuli, IT

When people think of the recent resurgence of natural wines, there is one name that stands out above the rest, Stanko Radikon. A true pioneer in the movement. The Radikon family vineyard is located in Oslavia, a small region near the border of Slovenia and Italy. Since 1980 Stanko and his wife Suzana have been producing some of the most sought after natural wines in the world. Sadly, in 2016 Stanko passed, leaving a legacy behind him that has since been upheld by his son Sasa who is now the vocal front man for the family vineyard. These are for the true lovers of orange wines

2018 Tocai Friulano, Radikon 'Jakot' 500ml 176

One of the longer macerated wines from Radikon's collection with time on skins for 2 to 3 months with further ageing in barrel for 3 years. More focused than the Ribolla.

2018 Ribolla Gialla, Radikon 'Ribolla' 500ml 176

Probably the most sought out and extreme wine in Radikon's 'Blue Label' collection. Just like its counterparts, it spends 2 to 3 months macerating on skins with further barrel aging lasting up to 3 years. Fresh yet complex, this is one for the true lovers of orange wine

2021 Pinot Grigio, Radikon 'Sivi' 176

Spending up to 14 days on skins with at least a year in barrel, results in a textual yet vibrant expression of this varietal. A good entry level wine for those new to Radikon

2021 Chardonnay Blend, Radikon 'Slatnik' 176

A blend of predominantly Chardonnay with a touch of Tocai Friulano that has been macerated on skins for up to 2 weeks. Ripe, opulent with lively acidity and fine tannin make for an approachable, yet delicious wine

2021 Merlot Blend, Radikon 'RS21' 176

A fantastic blend of Merlot and the lesser known Pigolo. A short time spent on skins followed by a year aged in barrel. Vibrant, yet fresh accompanied with well structured tannins. A wine of great energy and power

A true example of the potential of Adelaide Hills Shiraz - From a site planted in 2005 on Loam over Shale and Ironstone, this wine annually flies in the face of anyone who doubts Australian wines are wines of terroir.
- 2020 Syrah, Ngeringa 'Iluma' Adelaide Hills, SA 148
From a higher altitude spot at around 420m above sea level, the Biodynamically farmed Iluma Vineyard is home to Ngeringa's most prized fruit. Dominated by Micaschist and signature Adelaide Hills Ironstone, the wine is emblematic of the positive differences between the Hills and the other, more famous regions for SA Shiraz
- 2022 Shiraz Cabernet, Joshua Cooper 'Greytown,' Heathcote VIC 185
From rising star Joshua Cooper, a modernist winemaker with a keen sense of nostalgia; a single vineyard planted in the 1950s, mostly Shiraz with 'an unknown quantity of Cabernet Sauvignon' - co planted, co fermented, a beautiful weave of richness and freshness, deep fruit and aromatic herbs

Shiraz

2022 Shiraz, Kalleske Greenock Barossa Valley, SA 123

Grown from cuttings of vines originally planted in the 1880's. This Shiraz is planted over clay and limestone soil, that, accompanied by meticulous farming from 7th generation wine makers has created the perfect environment. Dark fruits, classy oak and excellent tannin

2021 Shiraz, Jasper Hill 'Georgia and Friends' Heathcote, VIC 194

One of Victoria's foremost cult wines; Georgia's Paddock Shiraz comes from a 45-year old vineyard operated by the Laughton family, dry grown and tended organically with the help of a few local neighbours. An amazing expression of Australian Shiraz

2021 Syrah, Golden Child '1-up' Blewitt Springs, SA 101

James from Golden Child has, for a while now, been chipping away in South Australia making wines that are as drinkable as they are thought provoking - this Syrah, from up to 90 year old vines in Blewitt Springs, made in tiny tiny quantities (to the point that it almost doesn't exist), is a perfect example

2018 Shiraz, David Franz 'Benjamin's Promise' Barossa Valley SA 168

A classic Barossa profile from a classic Barossa winemaker. Deep, dark fruits laced with spices and complexity, the results of a hallmark vintage.

2021 Moscato D'Asti, Massolino Piemonte, IT	750ml	126
Moscato, but with the fine details tucked in. Organic viticulture and native yeast ferment means this much maligned little sweet wine can be enjoyed with no secret shame - fresh, light and floral		
2017 Garganega, Canoso 'Recioto Di Soave', Veneto IT	500ml	173
From the late 1800s the Canoso family have tended to vineyards and farming in Veneto, producing the classic wines of the region in a sustainable way. This is the classic Venetian sweet wine, with distinct nuttiness and pie-crust character		
2019 Corvina Blend, Giuseppe Campagnola 'Recioto Della Valpolicella' Veneto, IT	500ml	165
The sweet wines of Veneto are a beautiful discovery; the classic grapes of Valpolicella, dried over the course of six months. A long slow ferment and patient resting gives a wine with fruit, spice and concentration		
2011 Trebbiano, Cantalici 'Vinsanto', Tuscany IT	375ml	146
From a family owned, reasonably modern winery in Gaiole in Chianti, this exception Vin Santo, or 'Holy Wine,' combines satisfying sweetness and texture with exceptional depth and complexity
