- 2019 Garaganega Blend, Campagnola 'Le Bine' Soave Classico Veneto, Italy 75  
Large classic Soave, singing pithy lemon, decent power and is and super-fresh acid
- 2019 Procanico Blend, Ajola 'Fishing Wine' Orvieto Umbria, Italy 120  
Funky Umbrian blend from a natty legend. Super fresh with a slight spritz, citrus and sea salt all here. 10.5% so you can slam it down fast (responsibly)
- 2020 Textural White Blend, JC's Own 'Freestyler' Barossa Valley, SA 90  
This is what happens when you let a classic winemaker loose in your shed. Chenin Blanc, Chardonnay, Sav B, Crouchen, you know, the usual suspects. Light lees stirring by 'driving it around the vineyard in a truck for a bit.' Whatever is it, it's waxy, broad and delicious
- 2019 Carricante Blend, Famiglia Statella Etna, Sicily, Italy 135  
Mediterranean Chablis? From inauspicious beginnings, Etna wine is now the most dangerous force - in popularity, and in positioning - in fine wine today. Grape growing on the slopes of Europe's largest active volcano? The secret ingredient... is DANGER
- 2019 Chardonnay, Pooley 'Butcher's Hill' TAS 150  
It's hard to have a serious discussion about Tasmanian wine without talking about the Pooley family. In the cool Coal River Valley they've created a wine empire, and single vineyard Chardonnay is their fort . Big, barrel fermented, orchard fruits and nut

From some mountain oddballs in the high country in southern Queensland; French inspired aromatic varietals made in the style and vessels of traditional Georgian wine
- 2019 Tocai Friulano Blend, Farnea 'Birbo' Colli Euganei  
Veneto, Italy 21 99  
Cult producer that overlooks the Colli Euganei national park – ten days in concrete, a couple weird varietals, but something so fresh, fleshy and fun about it
- 2017 Ribolla Gialla, Dario Princic 175  
Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy  
Dario Princic can be argued as one of the world's pre-eminent producers of Skin-Contact whites; in the company of Giants Stanko Radikon and Josko Gravner, this big three of natural winemaking have placed their stamp on the style and influenced wine drinking the world over
- 2019 Malvasia, Denavolo 'Dinavolino' 120  
Emilia-Romagna, Italy  
Off the personal estate of Giulio Armani, head winemaker at the legendary La Stoppa. Localised blend, loong time on skins; no additions for preservative, or for any other reason at all. Textural, savoury, nutty and complex
- 2019 Zibibbo, Serragghia 265  
Sicily, Italy  
From a tiny island between Sicily and Tunisia, Gabrio Bini produces what can be easily described as one of the world's ultimate cult wines; three months buried underground in clay Amphorae, on full skins, produce a wine of depth and character rarely matched. Dried fruit, flowers, spices. A WHOLE LOT going on

A beautiful couple in a beautiful place, producing beautiful wine. Candace and Frewin of CRFT have carved a niche for expressive wine, delicate balance and a sense of place		
2019 Pinot Noir, Moondarra 'Studebaker' Gippsland, VIC		115
A Neil Prentice project; he sold his old Studebaker to buy the first fence posts for his property at Moondarra. Guided by some mates with experience in the highest echelons of Burgundy, this is Pinot Noir with 'Funkosit�'		
2018 Pinot Noir, Apsley Gorge TAS		180
With every other vintage spent at Charlopin-Tissier and having even produced Clos De Vougeot at times, there's little Brian Franklin doesn't know about Pinot Noir. This is serious Australian Pinot		
2019 Barbera, Marina Coppi 'Sant'Andrea' Colli Tortonesi Piedmont, Italy		88
From the eastern reaches of Piedmont and established by the grandson of one of Italy's most famous cyclists, you could say a love for hills runs in the family. Classic Barbera character with earth and spices

- 2019 Dornfelder Blend, Hughes & Hughes 'Solstice' 65  
TAS  
Easily described as the best Dornfelder blend Tasmania has ever produced – a gothic grape so dark you can make ink from it, in an eclectic, semi-carbonic blend. Juicy, funky, plenty of pop n spice
- 2019 Nebbiolo, Cascina delle Rose 135  
Langhe, Piedmont, Italy  
From a family owned, sustainably farmed estate in the hills of Barbaresco, this is the fruit forward expression classic to the region. Steel only fresh and bright
- 2016 Nebbiolo, Sottimano 'Basarin' Barbaresco 285  
Piedmont, Italy  
The latest Cru release from Barbaresco's favourite family; elegant, finessed and perfumed yet structured, firm and powerful. Tar and Roses, as they say
- 2019 Malbec, Marq 72  
Margaret River, WA  
From an ex-lecturer in Wine Science and sensory evaluation, Marq Wines have formed themselves a reputation for creating nuanced and delicious wines that balance fruit purity and density with structure and food-friendliness
- 2018 Nerello Mascalese, Terre Nere 'Feudo di Mezzo' 220  
Etna, Sicily, Italy  
The establishment of the 'Contrade' or the Cru system on Mt Etna has been instrumental in the rise in esteem these wines have garnered. Firm tannin, smoke and a whole lot of minerality
- 2019 Sangiovese, Poggio Scalette, Chianti Classico 120  
Tuscany, Italy  
From the zone of Ruffoli, a more fruit forward expression of Chianti – Concrete tank for ferment and resting, purity of fruit with a pleasing earth is all the go here. Delicious
- 2017 Cabernet Blend, A. Rodda 'Cuvée de Chez' 94  
Beechworth, VIC  
A well experienced winemaker's ode to the classic bottle of Claret – from the soils of Beechworth's oldest vineyard, a good honest Aussie Red



## Red

- 2017 Sagrantino, Sassafras 75  
Hilltops, NSW  
The key red grape of Umbria, through a Hilltops/Canberra District lens. Dense purple fruits with a cocoa tone, how can it be dark and light at the same time?
- 2018 Primitivo, Inkwell 'Infidels' 65  
McLaren Vale, SA  
On a bed of Pirramimma sandstone in McLaren Vale, this Primitivo is hand-picked, treated to various oaks, and comes through with the goods in terms of full flavour, concentrated and a little bit spicy
- 2020 Grenache, JC's Own 'Férine' 88  
Barossa Valley, SA  
Here's what happens when you let an experienced conventional winemaker loose in his own backyard. Whole berry, carbonic ferment over six weeks from old school bush vine Grenache yields bubble-gummy red fruit character, but not at the expense of power and texture
- 2017 Nero D'Avola, Nino Barraco 145  
Sicily, Italy  
Pure and expressive Nero D'Avola from a Sicilian artisan of wine. Nino Barraco aims to only express the terroir of Marsala in any bottle of his wine. Minimal winemaker's thumbprint on this bad boy, just plump, juicy purple fruits and spice
- 2019 Shiraz, Jasper Hill 'Georgia's Paddock' 160  
Heathcote, VIC  
One of Victoria's foremost cult wines; Georgia's Paddock Shiraz comes from a 45-year old vineyard operated by the Laughton family, dry grown and tended organically. An amazing expression of Australian Shiraz

NV Cataratto, Pellegrino 'Superiore Garibaldi Dolce' 500ml Marsala, Sicily, Italy Killer, classic Sicilian Vino Dolce - deep amber, good with cheese, fruit, chocolate, coffee, by itself, on ice cream, in cakes, on cereal, in mixers. What a good choice!	6	50
NV Zibibbo, Alagna 'Angileri' Sicily, Italy Beautiful classic representation of fortified Zibibbo; all the delicate flowers backed up with a luscious sweetness	7	60
NV Zinfandel, Inkwel 'Dark Star Solera' 375ml McLaren Vale, SA Far from classic, the team at Inkwel have fortified up some Zinfandel and subjected it to the full Rutherglen Muscat treatment. Rich, deep, slick and sweet. Hello chocolate tart	19	99
2019 Moscato D'Asti, Fabio Perrone 375ml Piedmont, Italy Moscato, but with the fine details tucked in. Organic viticulture and native yeast ferment means this much maligned little sweet wine can be enjoyed with no secret shame - fresh, light and floral	15	70
